

Adding YouTube Videos

It is possible to embed a YouTube video into a page within Starz restricting the options for children as they view.

1. Visit YouTube and locate the video you wish to display



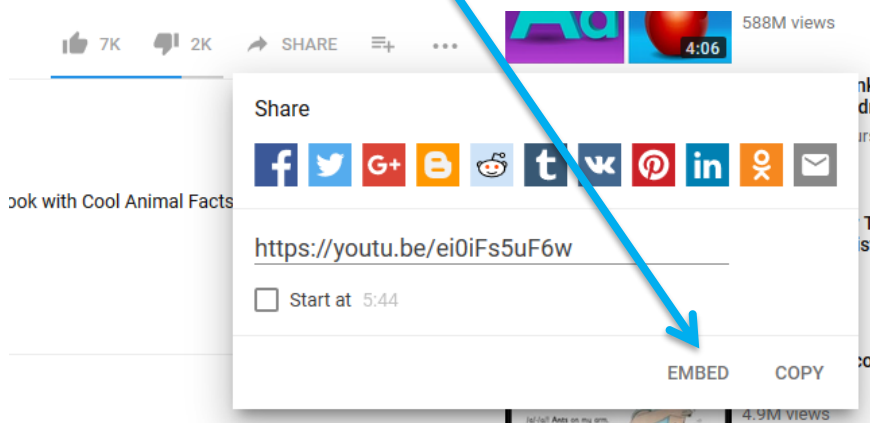

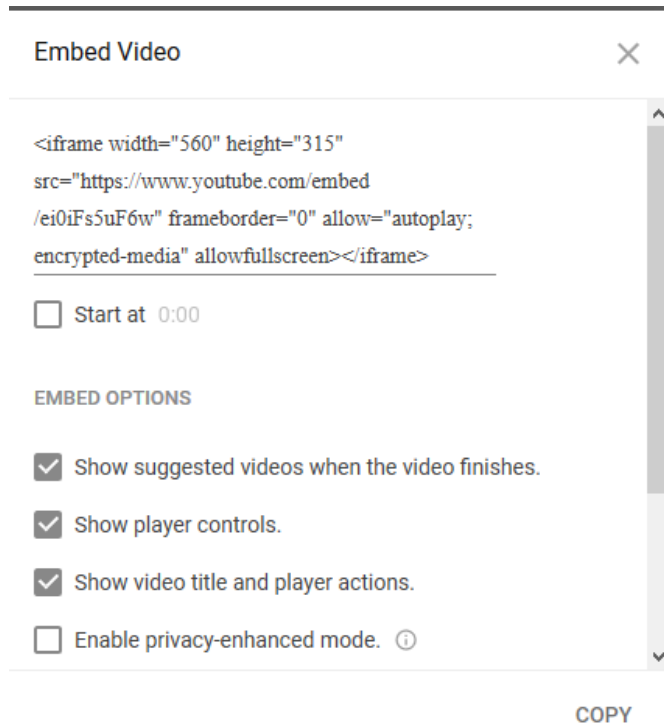

2. Click onto the 'Share' option

3. On the pop-up screen select 'Embed'.



4. On the second pop-up you can change the embed options



De-selecting all options will still display the video, but prevent the children from viewing further videos or visiting the main YouTube site.

As options are de-selected the embed code at the top of the pop-up will change. When you have changed your options to suit your needs, copy the embed code.

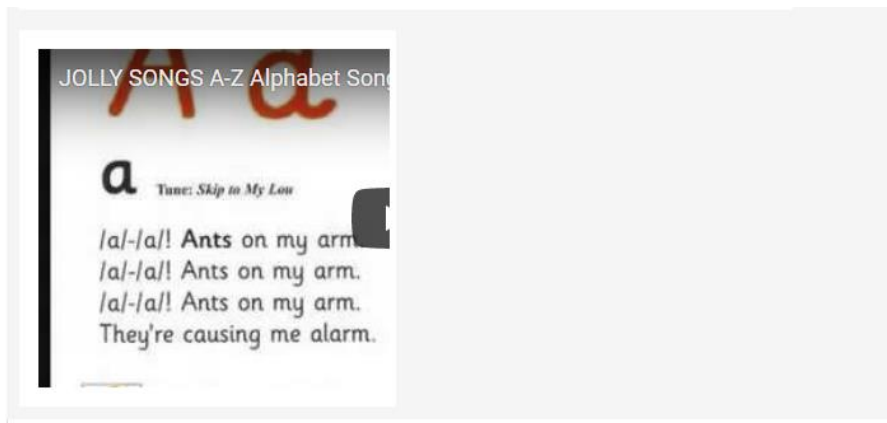
To embed on a Starz+ Page

In this example, I am adding the video to a Class page.

1. Select Set-up
2. Click onto Embed



- Paste the embed code that you have copied into the pop-up. Click Finish to save.
- The video will then be embedded into your class page.



- Bring your mouse over the corner of the image to display 'grab handles for re-sizing



Click into the centre of the image to click and drag to re-position the resource on the page.

- Save the change and/or Click the homepage tab to view how it will appear to your pupils.

NB: The process detailed above should also be used for embedding YouTube Videos into Project pages.
